Voyager Card Care Tips

All plastic fuel cards are subject to wear, fading and abrasion over time. However, by following these simple guidelines, the life of your Voyager card should extend past its expiration date.

- Store your card in a wallet or card carrier designed to fit a standard credit card.
- Do not expose the card to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for extended periods of time as this will cause the card to warp or melt. It is recommended that cards not be stored in vehicles where the outside temperature exceeds 100° F.
- Do not bend your card as it will cause stress to the plastic of the card and may cause breakage. This includes sitting or laying on a wallet that stores the card.
- Do not place your card within close proximity to strong magnets, including mobile phones.
- Do not immerse your card in water or use chemicals or abrasives to clean your card. If your card becomes dirty, use these steps to clean the card:
 1. Using a clean cloth, gently wipe the card until all the dirt and dust is gone.
 2. If needed, you can dampen the cloth with warm water, but do not immerse the card in water.
 3. Be sure to completely dry the card with a soft cloth.
